

## £5 Free Incoming Calls Whilst Roaming Terms & Conditions

The Airtel-Vodafone £5 add-on for free incoming calls whilst roaming Terms and Conditions should be read in conjunction with the Airtel-Vodafone general Pay Monthly or Post-Paid Terms and Conditions as highlighted under the terms and conditions links on [www.airtel-vodafone.com](http://www.airtel-vodafone.com).

Where there is conflict between the Airtel-Vodafone £5 add-on for free incoming calls whilst roaming Terms and Conditions and the general Airtel-Vodafone Pay Monthly or Post Paid Terms and Conditions, the specific Terms and Conditions from the Airtel-Vodafone £5 add-on for free incoming calls whilst roaming shall apply, but all other provisions within the general Airtel-Vodafone Pay Monthly or Post Paid Terms and Conditions shall remain in full force and effect.

1. The £5 add-on for free incoming calls whilst roaming is an 'optional' add-on pack that Customers can choose to add onto their existing Pay Monthly account; so that when they roam worldwide they can receive free incoming calls from any number.
2. This add-on pack is only applicable for new and existing Pay Monthly Voice customers and not for Data only Customers or any Pay-As-You-Go Customers.
3. The £5 add-on for free incoming calls whilst roaming is valid for one month when activated on the Customer's account. & will roll over each month unless Airtel-Vodafone are instructed by the authorised account holder to remove the add-on service from their account.
4. Customers are unlimited as to how many times they wish to add &/or remove the £5 add-on roaming pack.
5. The £5 monthly fee will not be pro-rated and will be debited from the account holders bank account as per Airtel-Vodafone's billing cycle which is 20<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> of each month.
6. It is the sole responsibility of the Customer for requesting the £5 free incoming calls roaming add-on pack to be activated and deactivated from their account.
7. Airtel-Vodafone reserves the right to remove this plan at any time.
